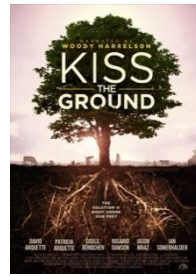


**The New Men's Fellowship Group

LPC Worships On the Road!

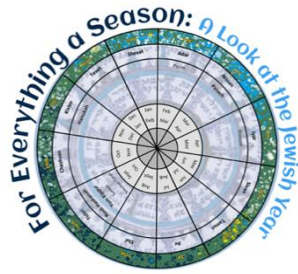

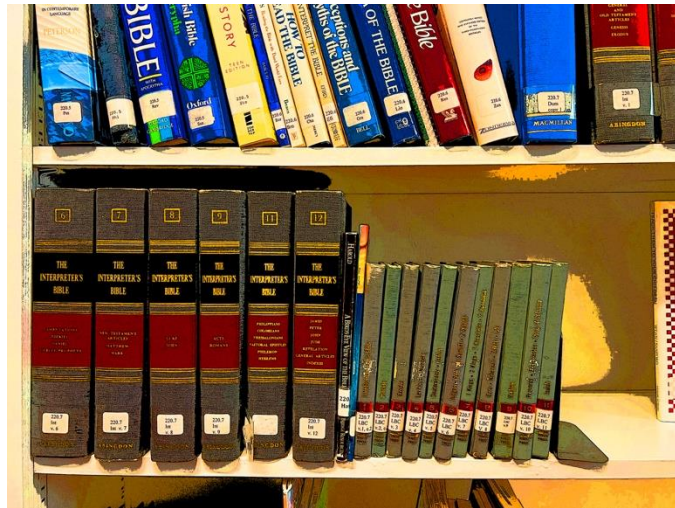
